
USER RECOMMENDATIONS

STORAGE




- Store panels horizontally in a dry place.
- Unpainted panels should be covered if left outside.

PAINT

- Avoid contact with moisture (soil, grass, etc.).
- Minimize the time untreated panels are stored outside.

CUTTING AND PAINTING








- Use standard hand tools for wood to cut the panels if necessary.
- Clean the surface of the panels from dust.
- No need to sand, prime or put biocide coating.
- You may use standard indoor or outdoor paints suited for wooden surfaces.
- Alkyd and acrylic paints are compatible with SVEZA Paint. Avoid alkali paints and acrylate putty.
- Test the suitability of the paint in accordance with paint producers' instructions. A test coating with cross-cut test* is recommended prior to use.
- Follow the paint producers' instructions carefully.
- Plywood should be painted from all sides.
- Paint carefully the edges of plywood panels, especially when used outside. Round off and smooth the edges for better result.
- Maintain stable air humidity while painting.

* Cross-cut test is used to test the adhesion of dry coats of paint on their substrate. There are two series of parallel cuts cross angled to each other to obtain a pattern of 25 or 100 similar squares. The ruled area is evaluated after a short treatment with adhesive tape for hard substrates.

INSTALLATION



- Working place should be dry.
- The panels might undergo dimensional changes due to changes in air humidity.
- When installing leave the ventilation gap (of 1-2 mm) between the panels.
- Always fill in the holes made in the course of installation work to prevent from moisture penetration.

MAINTENANCE



- Regular inspections and maintenance of surface and edges are recommended to make your panels last longer.
- Touch-up painting should be given to a specialist and done in accordance with paint producers' instructions.
